ATHENS TRACK GRAND PRIX 2022 TECHNICAL GUIDE

1. General Organization

The **Hellenic Cycling Federation** organises the **Athens Track Grand Prix 2022** (UCI Cat.2 International Track Meeting for Elite and Junior Categories), **in April 28, 2022**

The Athens Track Grand Prix 2022 will be organized under the following details and rules:

- 1.1. Competition Venue:** Athens Olympic Velodrome, 250m. Indoor Track, wooden surface. Velodrome address: OAKA Complex, Spyrou Loui avenue, 151 23 Maroussi, Athens – Greece.
- 1.2. Regulations:** All events shall be organized in accordance with the latest version of the UCI Regulations taking into consideration specific regulations mentioned below.
- 1.3. Penalties:** UCI scale of penalties is the only one applicable shall apply to this Grand Prix.
- 1.4. Doping:** In case of National Anti-Doping Organisation decides to apply any drug-test, information will be distributed during Team Managers Meeting.

2. Participation / Specific Regulations

2.1. Participation: The Athens Track Grand Prix 2022 is open to National teams, Track Teams, Regional Teams and Cycling Clubs. The organizer has the right to select the teams according to objective and sporting criteria.

2.3. Races maximum participation:

The maximum participation numbers per discipline will be the following:

Each team or individual riders can start as many disciplines as he/she wishes.

NOTE: Depending to the number of entries in Scratch, Points Race, Elimination and Omnium, qualification heats shall be organized in order to qualify the maximum permitted number of riders/teams by the regulations.

- 2.4. **Participation:** Junior of 18 years old can also participate in all disciplines as Elite riders.
- 2.5. **Team Sprint:** Riders from different clubs shall make a Team Sprint team in order to compete.

3. Entries – Meetings

- 3.1. **Entries:** Entries including names of riders, substitutes, accompanying members shall reach organiser's head office, submitted by on Entry Forms provided by the Organiser on

Wednesday, 20th of April 2022

at the latest to the following e-mail: eopbike@otenet.gr

Entrants for all the events shall hold UCI licences issued by a Federation affiliated to UCI.

- 3.2. **Race Secretariat:** The race secretariat will be open on **Wednesday 27th of April, 2022 from 17:00 – 19:30** at Hellenic Cycling Federation office, Athens Olympic Velodrome Spirou Loui Ave. 151 23 Maroussi – Athens, Greece. Tel. +30 210 6859788.
- 3.3. **Licences and starters verification - Distribution of race numbers.** Team managers must verify the riders to participate in each discipline, **Wednesday 27th of April, 2022 from 17:00 – 19:30** at the race secretariat. Team managers must present riders' licences and passports if necessary for juniors riders.
- 3.4. **Team Managers meeting.** The Team Managers meeting will be held on **Wednesday 27th of April 2022 at 20:00** in the Olympic Velodrome meeting room. It must be attended by all officials and Team Managers.
- 3.5. **Commissaires Panel.** The President of the Panel (UCI International Commissaire) and the members of the Commissaires Panel shall be appointed by the organising federation.

- 4.1. **Awards.** The 3 winners (individual or team) in each event shall receive from the organiser, respectively, a gold medal (1st place), a silver medal (2nd place) and a bronze medal (3rd place).
