HELLENIC XCO CUP 2025 #1 (National XCO Series)

Technical Guide

The **Hellenic Cycling Federation** organizes mountain bike race included into the UCI calendar, under the name **Hellenic XCO CUP 2025 - Race #1**, in the categories of Men Elite/U23, Women Elite/U23, Men Junior, Women Junior. Also will be run races for Youth, U17 (Boys/Girls), U15 (Boys/Girls) and Master (Men - Women). The race #1 of the series is organized in Salamina Island, in collaboration with **A.S. Proteas sportsclub**.

The categories Men and Women (Elite/U23/Junior) are integrated into the UCI racing calendar (Mountain Bike UCI Calendar - Category C2) and competition gives points in the world ranking, as follows:

1.2 Location/Course:

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1.3 Participation/Registration

1.3.1 Each team or club, has the right to participate in the races with an unlimited number of participants in the categories mentioned above. Cyclists, licence holders of affiliated UCI member federations are also entitled to participate.

1.3.2 For team/club/riders other than licence holders of Hellenic Cycling Federation must fully fill the official entry form.

1.3.3 Team Manager/representative/aatendant of teams must also be mentioned into official forms.

1.3.4 Participation fee: Elite/U23, U19 categories: €30, Master, U17, U15 Categories: €15

1.3.5 The fees will be paid by deposit into the bank account of the Hellenic Cycling Federation with IBAN: GR5802601530000020200654714 (Eurobank). Any bank charges must be paid by the participants. The entry form and deposit proof must be sent by **Tuesday 25/02/2025** to the e-mail: eopbike@otenet.gr

1.3.6 Any rider or team or club that will not send the official entry form for the races, will not be able to participate.

1.3.7 N/A

1.3.8 There will be one ranking for the Elite and U23 categories (based on UCI regulations)

1.3.9 There will be a separate ranking for the Master age groups Men/Women 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+.

1.3.10 The final start list will be announced after the Technical meeting and will include the cyclists who have confirmed their participation and received their bib numbers.

1.4 Secretariat Location and Hours of Operation:

The Secretariat will operate, according to the above schedule, in a place near the starting point of the course. During operating hours, the check of the licences and the collection of the race numbers will take place. The use of numbers is also mandatory in the official training.

1.5 Technical Conference:

According to the schedule. The presence of the team leaders is mandatory.

1.6 Race regulations:

1.6.1 Race will be held according to the UCI regulations. Special provisions and Race Regulation of the Greek Cycling Federation, will be also apply to other than UCI Categories

1.6.2 One feeding zone (double) will be located near the start/finish area.

1.6.3 The starting order will be determined by the UCI classification for the XCO, then by the National Cup ranking, then by the last individual classification of the cyclists announced by Hellenic Cycling Federation.

1.6.4 The Panel of Commissaires will decide, taking into account also the weather conditions, the number of laps, and if and whether to apply the 80% or 100% (lapped) rule regarding the classification of riders who are late during the race.

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1.7 Technical aspects:

1.7.1 Cyclists are obliged to monitor their equipment and its condition.

1.7.2 Cyclists who belong to a team recognized by the UCI (National or MTB Team) will compete with the official uniform of this team.

1.8 Prizes:

1.8.1 Medal to the first five winners of each category. Additional award to the best ranked U23 rider. In the Master categories (men - women), the awards will be per age group, provided that each group includes three cyclists, otherwise they will be consolidated with the nearest most populous category.

1.8.2 Prizes for the Elite/U23 (Men - Women), and Junior (Men - Women) according to the UCI Regulations (Cat.2/Group.2), as follows:

1.8.3 The money prizes will be given after the end of the race, in a place next to Race Secretariat, directly to the winners, upon presentation of their licence.

1.9 Awards Ceremonies:

1.9.1 They will be held in a place near the Start/Finish area, according to the schedule.

1.9.2 Cyclists will be presented to the awards ceremony in their racing attire, without bikes and without accessories (sunglasses, hats, water bottles, etc.).

1.10 Anti-Doping Control:

In case that the National Anti-Doping Organization decides to conduct tests, there will be information for those involved, in accordance with the regulations of the Hellenic Cycling Federation, the UCI and NADO.

1.11 Penalties:

The penalties specified in the UCI and Hellenic National Federation regulations will be applied in the race.

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1.14.2 All participants in the competition in any form, athletes, coaches, attendants, spectators and all those involved in the organization, accept that their personal data, competition results with their performances, photographs, videos, shall be given to the media, and be processed by the organizer of the competition and its co-organizers.

1.14.3 The competition program may be modified according to the specificities of the competition.

1.14.5 Commissaires Panel in collaboration with organizer and Hellenic Cycling Federation Technical delegate are responsible for the preparation and formalization of the competition program as well as for anything not provided for in this guide.
